Following her passion for music, she devoted the first two decades of her work to music ministry at four Catholic grade schools: St. Aloysius in West Allis, Wisconsin, St. Mary in Elm Grove, Wisconsin, St. James in Madison, Wisconsin, and Holy Childhood in Harbor Springs, Michigan. In 1982, Sister Jean Arthur turned to health care ministry, working in Elm Grove, Wisconsin, at Notre Dame Health Care Center for eight years as a medical technologist. From 1990-2012, she served as a full-time staff medical technologist at Milwaukee's St. Francis Hospital. Since 2012, she has resided in prayerful presence at the SSND residence in West Milwaukee. She earned a bachelor's degree in music education from the former Mount Mary College in Milwaukee, followed by a master's degree in music history from the University of Wisconsin.
